

The health care workforce landscape today: 10 key trends


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Total employment in nursing facilities remains 10% below the pre-pandemic level. Ambulatory care settings are growing faster than inpatient.






The number of APRNs is growing 7 times faster than the number of PCPs. All workforces continue to grow, growth has slowed over the past 5 years.









Differential growth rates have led to a provider mix with fewer physicians.








The Medicare 1997 cap on funding of residency slots does not appear to be a big factor in physician supply


Applicants and 1st Year Positions in the Match, 1952 - 2023

Exhibit 2. Percentage of physicians working directly for a hospital or a practice at least partially owned by a hospital or health system, 2012-2020










The travel nursing frenzy has largely died down




Number of weekly travel nurse job listings as compiled by SimpliFi, 2020-2023.




The nursing workforce has rebounded in total employment post-pandemic
